

Sacrament of Baptism - Baptisms are celebrated at 12:00 PM every 2nd and 3rd Sundays of month, immediately following the 11:00 AM Mass. Parents must meet with Deacon Diep Nguyen before the child is baptized. Please call Deacon Nguyen at 610-804-0908 or e-mail him at diepdione@gmail to make an appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage - Please call Father Trinh at least six months before your wedding to begin preparations.

Sacrament of the Sick - Please call the Rectory at anytime for emergencies. The homebound are visited regularly by Father Trinh and the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. If you or a family member is hospitalized and would like a visit, please call the Rectory. Please call the Rectory, also, if you would like to be anointed before you are hospitalized.

Letters of Eligibility - Prior to your being a godparent at Baptism or a sponsor at Confirmation, you must receive a Letter of Eligibility from Divine Mercy Parish. You must be a registered parishioner who is at least 16 years of age, who has already received Confirmation, who comes to Mass on Sundays and Holydays, and, if married, is married in the Church. Please call the Rectory to arrange to meet with Father Trinh when you need a Letter of Eligibility.

If you would like to get a current baptismal certificate or a current marriage certificate, please provide us the following information.;

- 1. An Original Copy of your Baptismal Certificate or Marriage Certificate. If you don't have this information, for Baptismal Certificate, please tell us what particular Church where you were baptized, since Divine Mercy Parish is the merge of Saint Clement Church, Saint Raphael Church, St. Vincent Church, Saint Irenaeus Church and Good Shepherd Church. Also provide us your date of birth, the date of your baptism, your full name, your father's name, your mother's maiden name and your god-parents' name. For Marriage Certificate, please tell us what particular Church where you were married, the date of your marriage, your full name, your parents' full names, your spouse's maiden name and your spouse's parents' full names.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

- A Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.
- **B** Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to
- C Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that all the graces of His mercy can only be received by our trust. The more we open the door of our hearts and lives to Him with trust, the more we can receive.

I am love and mercy itself. ... Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. ... My mercy is greater than your sins, and those of the entire world. ... I let My Sacred Heart be pierced with a lance, thus opening wide the source of mercy for you. Come then with trust to draw graces from this fountain. ... The graces of My mercy are drawn by the means of one vessel only, and that is trust. The more a soul trusts, the more it will receive.

PLANNERY INDULGENCE GRANTED ON THE DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

A plenary indulgence can be obtained by going to a church on Divine Mercy Sunday after making a confession beforehand and receiving Communion "in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin," and participating in the prayers held in honor of Divine Mercy.

I desire that the first Sunday after Easter be the Feast of Mercy. Ask of my faithful servant [Fr. Sopocko] that on this day, he tell the whole world of My great mercy; that whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment. Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My mercy. ... My Heart rejoices in this title of Mercy. Proclaim that mercy is the greatest attribute of God. All the works of My hands are crowned with mercy.

CHÚA NHẬT LÒNG THƯƠNG XỚT CHÚA

Mạc khải Lòng Thương Xót Chúa có thể tóm gọn 3 bước theo thứ tự ABC.

A - Hãy cầu xin Lòng Thương Xót Chúa. Một linh hồn tội lỗi Chúa không thể yêu thương được, tuy nhiên nếu linh hồn đó ăn năm sám hối và xin Chúa xót thương, thì Chúa sẽ yêu thương linh hồn ấy vô cùng và ban cho linh hồn ấy nhiều ân sủng hơn là linh hồn ấy xin. Cho nên chúng ta hãy luôn cầu nguyện sám hối và cầu xin Lòng

Thương Xót Chúa cho chúng ta và toàn thế giới. Cầu xin Lòng Thương Xót Chúa làm cho Chúa rất vui và đẹp lòng Chúa.

- **B** Hãy thương xót nhau. Sau khi đón nhận lòng Thương Xót Chúa, chúng ta hãy thương xót và tha thứ cho nhau, hầu trở nên máng cháy của sự tha thứ và Lòng Thương Xót Chúa chuyển tiếp cho nhau. Như Chúa đã xót thương và tha thứ cho ta, thì ta cũng cần yêu thương và tha thứ cho nhau.
- C Hoàn toàn tin tưởng và phó thác cho Chúa. Chúa muốn chúng ta phải biết rằng: chỉ có một cách duy nhất để thông phần vào nguồn ân sủng và Lòng Thương Xót không vô biên sâu thẳm của Chúa, đó là sự tin tưởng phó thác nơi Chúa. Càng tin tưởng và phó thác cuộc đời cho Chúa bao nhiêu, thì chúng ta càng đón nhận ân sủng và Lòng Thương Xót Chúa bấy nhiêu.

Ta chính là Tình Yêu và Lòng Thương Xót... Bất cứ linh hồn nào cũng đừng sợ hãi đển với ta, cho dù tội lỗi của nó nặng đến đâu đi chăng nữa... Lòng Thương Xót của ta lớn hơn tội lỗi của con người, cho dù tội lỗi của toàn thế giới cộng lại... Ta đã để cho lưỡi đòng đâm thấu tim Ta, để cho nguồn mạch Lòng Thương Xót tuôn trào ra cho nhân loại. Hãy đến với niềm tin tưởng để múc đầy ân sủng từ nguồn mạch nay... Tất cả ân thánh tuôn ra từ nguồn mạch này chỉ có thể hứng đầy được chỉ bằng một cách duy nhất, đó chính là tin tưởng phó thác. Càng tin tưởng nhiều, con càng nhận được nhiều hồng ân.

ON TOÀN XÁ NHẬN LÃNH TRONG ĐẠI LỄ LÒNG THƯƠNG XÓT CHÚA

Để lãnh nhận ơn Toàn Xá, cần phải Xưng Tội, Tham Dự Thánh Lễ, và Rước Lễ với tâm tình hoàn toàn từ bở tất cả tội lỗi dù là tội nhẹ. Đồng thời Đọc Chuổi Kinh Lòng Chúa Thương Xót, hoặc Đọc Kinh Tin Kính, Kinh Lạy Cha, và cầu nguyện theo ý Đức Thánh Cha, hoặc viếng Thánh Thể trong Nhà Tạm hay được để ra bên ngoài.
